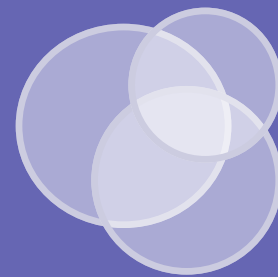


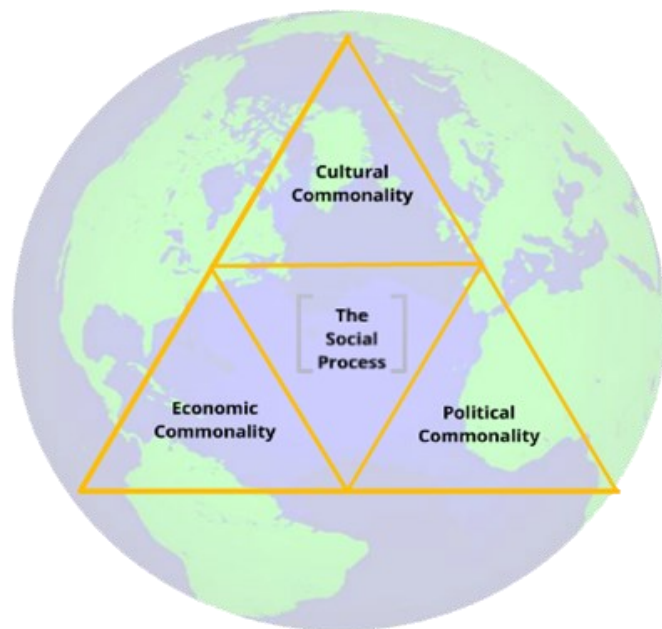
# Sustainable Community Development Training
